ITSY

Everyone *assumes* I'm some criminal—that those five monkeys who jumped on that bed paid me to doctor their insurance claims; or that I helped Dish and Spoon skip bail. Or that I'm behind today's burglaries. All these crimes have been linked to me, but I'm *innocent*. Someone out there is steering this ship and they won't *rest* until I'm underwater.

You wanna hear some irony? (*Pointing to herself:*) This "corrupt" cop *leads* the Water Spout precinct's anti-corruption task force. I have locked up more corrupt officials than any cop in this town's *history*.

But *every time* I climb my way up the Water Spout ranks, down comes a reign of fire, a reign of terror—call it what you will, but down comes the reign and it comes down hard.

And y'know what? (Holding back emotion:) It washes me right out. Right. Out.

I've been climbin' my whole life. And just when I'm near the top, BAM, back to rock bottom. I just don't know if I've got the courage to start that climb again.

I'm drowning here, people. (With severe intensity:) And the sun ain't comin' out...
